Dear Administrators and Teachers,

The Survive Alive House looks forward to working with you and your students again this year.

The fifth graders will attend during the first semester and second grade students will be scheduled in the second semester. This will allow the second graders to take advantage of the skills they have developed during the early part of the school year.

The early session begins at 9:30 am and leaves by 11:00 am. The late session will start at 11:30 am and depart by 1:00 pm. Please advise your food nutrition supervisor of your field trip so they may make special arrangements for lunch.

Please pay special attention to your bus pick up time (9 am or 11 am). ***If the bus has not arrived at the appointed time, please immediately call 385-3240 to report the problem.*** You will receive a bus schedule reminder approximately 3 weeks before your scheduled visit.

Please make sure ***all*** 2nd or 5th graders are attending the program. Many special needs students benefit from the presentation. Adults that work with your students are encouraged to attend. The Survive Alive House is ADA compliant. If students are sound sensitive we have headsets available. Please inform the staff when you arrive if you have any special needs.

If your school and/or students need a Spanish presentation, please notify us when you receive this appointment confirmation. We have some printed Spanish and Hmong materials that are available upon request or on our website.

We also request you provide a current class list with the students' first and last names. A homeroom list works best. The class list ensures that we are posting information to the proper student when it is entered in their record. Please note students not in attendance.

We encourage you to review the curriculum with your class prior to attending. Review materials and recommendations are included in this packet and can be found online at survivealivemilwaukee.com, located under the teachers tab.

There have been many deaths caused by fire in the City of Milwaukee. A common theme in these tragedies is the lack of working smoke detectors. In order to combat this problem, we are requesting that, you distribute the attached **Student/Parent Home Check List** when you send home the MPS field trip permission slip and waiver.
